The Brightwater Education/Community Center Advisory Group is asking the Woodinville Chamber of Commerce Business Members for input as to their potential use of an Education/Community Center on the Brightwater property. This property is located on Highway 9 north of Woodinville. King County is in the design stages of providing a facility that can be used not only as an education facility for the local schools but also as a community center for the local businesses. Funds for the project are part of the mitigation for the Brightwater system. The plan is to design a building that will meet multiple needs of the community and that the local businesses would be proud to hold an off-site training session, a formal luncheon, or evening dinner affair.

It has been mentioned that this area has few places to use for an event for 200 - 300 hundred people or even for a small 20-30 person gathering on a limited budget. Please take a few moments and consider how your company could use such a facility, for how many people and what type of special physical amenities (ie digital equipment, video conferencing) your event would need.
