Dear Mr. Sharkansky:

Regarding the above numbered Public Disclosure Request I have some records available which respond to your request. Some of the questions posed do not have public records associated with them and are requests for information. Neither individuals nor departments are obligated to provide such information except on a voluntary basis, particularly when it is personal in nature.

On behalf of the Councilmembers I have the following:

1. Information Question: How do you commute to work?
Richard Conlin in a prior response indicates that he rides bus or bike.
David Della drives a personal car.
Sally Clark drives a personal car.
No other personal information was provided.
The city provides a subsidy for bus passes/tickets of \$180 for a year of use.
2. Records question: Does the City provide free or subsidized parking.
No subsidized parking is provided per Ordinance 113007 for Councilmembers. Council members Drago and Conlin do not use the parking available for pay. Parking in City Hall costs \$220 month and an unreserved space in SeaPark Garage costs \$180 per month.
3. Records question: ...all reports of intracity transportation ...paid in 2005.
Our records are available for Council for 2005. Since there are very few charges of this nature the data is not lengthy and in two cases there are no charges at all. These records are available for viewing and/or copying by contacting Jeff Ware of the City Clerk's office at 684-8344. There is a copy fee of \$.15/page.

4. Information question: ...estimate of travel modes within Seattle on business...
Richard Conlin provided this information in a prior response.
David Della states "walk 60%, bus 15%, personal 25%"
Sally Clark replies that for close destinations she walks or uses city bus for neighborhoods further away she uses person car. (No % provided)
No other information provided.
We have no records of mileage reimbursement requests from Councilmembers for this purpose in 2005. (This is typical for most years.)

5. Information question: "make and model of vehicle"
Richard Conlin provided this information in a prior response.
No other information provided.
