Dear Mr. Young:

On July 26, 2005, my office received a public disclosure request from you dated July 20, 2005.

In your request, you asked that we send you the following documents:

Licensing Services Division

1. Any documents on the subject of duplicate registrations, including:
 - a. lists of identified and suspected duplicate registrations
 - b. reports with statistics on the numbers of known or suspected duplicate registrations
 - c. any documents that discuss policies, procedures and/or plans for removing duplicate registrations – going back three years
2. Any documents on procedures for processing new voter registrations, including any older versions of since updated documents going back three years.
3. Any documents relating to incidents where individuals are suspected of submitting ballots under multiple registrations.
4. Screen shots of the DMS records, copies of the absentee ballot envelopes submitted in the November 2004 election and any other documents pertaining to the following registered voters:..." (reference the list provided in your July 20, 2005 letter).

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As today is the fifth business day following receipt of your request, this letter serves as our initial response. We are in the process of identifying records that are responsive to your request. At this time, we expect that it will take us approximately ten days to gather documents responsive to Items 1-3 and have them ready to begin copying. We will contact you as soon as




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the documents have been assembled, since we will need to receive payment (\$.15/page) before we begin the copying phase.

It will take considerably longer to provide copies of the requested absentee ballot envelopes. We should be able to give you a more specific estimate of the time frame for responding to that portion of your request (Item No. 4 in your letter) when we contact you about August 11.
