Re: Possible Fraudulent Voter Registration

Dear Mr. Satterberg:

The enclosed voter registration forms were received by the King County Records, Elections, and Licensing Services Division over the last couple of months. The Elections Division suspects that fraudulent voter registration may have occurred with respect to some or all of the enclosed registrations. In reviewing the registrations, staff was initially concerned with the similarities in handwriting, including the signatures. Further investigation by staff revealed that many of the individuals whose names appear on the enclosed registration forms are already registered to vote. Comparison of these voters' signatures that are on file with the Elections Division and the signatures on the enclosed forms, revealed many discrepancies in the appearance of the signatures.

Pursuant to RCW 29.85.245, the Elections Divisions has made contact with a number of the individuals whose names appear on the enclosed registration forms. As a result of these contacts, I still believe it is likely that fraudulent voter registration has occurred. Therefore, I am referring this issue to your office for a determination of whether further action is warranted.

I understand that the King County Sheriff's Office will be conducting an investigation into this matter. If your office or the Sheriff's Office has any questions or needs any additional information from the Elections Division, please do not hesitate to contact me at 296-1548.
