Dear Director Logan:

Under RCW 42.17, I am requesting the following public records and understand that you must send a response to us within 5 business days of receipt of this letter. The documents requested pertain to the November 8, 2005 General Election. We would like to receive these documents prior to the certification of the election by the Canvassing Board.

Please send the following documents:

1. The database of active and inactive registered voters as of election day.
2. A table of all canceled voters still in database on Election Day, including date and reason for cancellation.
3. A table of voters whose registrations were fatally pended on Election Day, including reason for pend.
4. The absentee voter table (AVS multipurpose tape), which includes all absentee ballots issued and returned and disposition. This should include every ballot's voter ID, AV election ID, batch number, sequence number, return date, challenge code and last transaction date.
5. The GEMS cards cast report.
6. A list of all voters who cast accepted federal write-in ballots, to include name, local address and assigned precinct.
7. A complete provisional ballot table of all provisional ballots processed including complete name, voter ID, envelope serial number, final disposition whether counted or reason rejected, and last transaction date.
8. A report of voters who might have voted more than once.
