MOTION TO VACATE SEPTEMBER 28,
2006 ORDER TO BREAK SEAL

The undersigned attorney of record for Ronald Dotzauer moves the Court for an Order Vacating the September 28, 2006 Order to Break Seal entered in this matter.

1. **Relief Requested:** Entry of an Order Vacating the September 28, 2006 Order to Break Seal entered by a Pro Tem Court Commissioner on September 28, 2006, preserving the status quo ante and assigning this matter for any further proceedings to The Honorable Thomas J. Wynne, Presiding Judge of the Snohomish County Superior Court.

2. **Statement of Facts:** The file in this matter was sealed many years ago. The State Supreme Court has adopted specific rules that govern any request to unseal sealed records in a civil case. GR 15(d)(2). Those rules require that sealed files may be unsealed “only upon stipulation of all parties or upon motion and written notice to the person entitled to notice....” (Emphasis added.) Moreover, SCLGR 15 expressly provides that motions to seal or redact court records “shall be noted before a Judge or regularly appointment Court Commissioner. Motions to seal or redact may not be heard by a Judge Pro Tem or Court Commissioner Pro Tem.” (Emphasis added.) The undersigned filed his appearance in this matter on September

1 21, 2006. A copy of the Notice is attached. He also wrote the attached letter to the Honorable
2 Thomas J. Wynne on September 22, 2006.

3 On September 28, 2006, without notice and in total disregard of GR 15 and SCLR 15, a
4 Pro Tem Commissioner, acting ex parte, unlawfully signed the attached Order to Break Seal and
5 unlawfully authorized a "Stefan Sharkansky" to examine and procure copies of those records.

6 Subsequently, the alleged content of the unlawfully unsealed file was made public
7 causing significant continuing damage to Ronald Dotzauer.

8 Despite the fact that one cannot un-ring a bell, Ronald Dotzauer asks that the status quo
9 ante be immediately re-instituted and that the Order to Break Seal be immediately vacated, the
10 file in this matter be sealed until further order of this court and that jurisdiction over this entire
11 matter be retained only by The Honorable Thomas J. Wynne, Judge of the Snohomish County
12 Superior Court.

13 3. **Statement of Issues:** Shall the September 28, 2006 Order to Break Seal be
14 immediately vacated, the status quo ante be immediately re-instituted, the file in this matter be
15 resealed until further order of the court and jurisdiction over this matter be retained only by The
16 Honorable Thomas J. Wynne, Judge of the Snohomish County Superior Court?

17 4. **Evidence Relied Upon:** See, the above which is attested to by counsel pursuant
18 to CR 11, the court file in this matter, and judicially recognizable facts reference above.




